- Four entries per event and on entry per relay
- Will score the top eight places (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1)
- Preliminaries - Shot, Discus, Long and Triple Jump (top 9 will advance to finals)
- All jumps and throws will be measured
- Weigh-ins for the shot and discus will take place on the picnic tables between the new gym and the football field/track
- After implements are weighed in they will need to go directly to the event and placed in the containers located there. Athletes may use more than one legal implement
- For the purpose of risk management, warm-ups in a field event may not take place until the venue is declared open and required supervision is in place.

Team Camps: Camps may be set up on the grassy area between the Football Field, School Building and New Gym

Hats and Sunglasses: No hats or head coverings of any kind. Headbands will be allowed if they are a single color and only one manufacturer's logo larger than 2 ¼ inches. Sunglasses will be allowed if they are for sun block

Warm-Up Area: Only competitors in uniform will be allowed on the infield to warm up one event prior to their event

Warm Up (Field Events): Only after the event official has opened the event for warm up and must be supervised by the official or coach. Once the event is over and the event judge has closed the venue, no further practice is allowed

Uniforms: Athletes shall wear a school issued or school-approved full length track top and track bottoms or a one piece uniform. The uniform may have the school name, logo and/or

nickname, and competitor's name. T-shirts with "Throwers", "Jumpers", or any other event name printed on either the front or back is illegal as a track uniform

- Competitors must leave the track and warm-up area as soon as possible after their event
- Official times will be posted around the venue. If the wind reading is over the max, we will use the next best jump to turn into MaxPreps. If the wind reading is good, we will score the best jump for individuals during the meet for placing
- All relay teams must wear uniforms clearly indicated through predominant color, school logo, and color combination of all outer garments worn as a uniform that members from the same team
- All relay team members will be checked (by the clerk) on the following:
 - Uniform top has the same predominate color in the front and same school name or logo on the front
 - Uniform back has the same design in the back
 - Uniform bottom has the same predominant color in the front and back
 - Side panels or side striping on the uniform top and bottom, whether they exist or not should not be a factor in determining compliance
 - Any visible garment worn underneath the uniform top and/or bottom is not subject to logo/trademark/reference or color restrictions
 - It is the Games Committee decision if shirts need to be tucked in
 - Shorts and bras cannot be rolled up

Bus Parking: Buses may park in either the front school parking lot or the new gym parking lot

Concession Stand: Swink will run a full concession stand

Hospitality Room: Swink will provide a hospitality room for coaches and bus drivers and will be given a lunch ticket to redeem at the concession stand
